

## **Fellowship Opportunity for ECA Staff at Johns Hopkins University, Washington DC.**

The UNECA has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the John Hopkins University (JHU), Washington, DC.

In the MOU, both John Hopkins University, a renowned academic institution involved in research, knowledge production, training and capacity development and the UNECA agree to cooperate in broad areas of activities including research, internships and fellowships, policy discourse and analysis, seminars, conferences, and other areas of mutual interest. The MOU makes it possible for ECA to showcase its works and publications to the knowledge and policy community in Washington, DC to be organized by JHU and for ECA staff traveling to Washington, DC to give seminars, and lectures on their current work.

The fellowship opportunity contained in the MOU allows ECA staff wishing to conduct research and critical reflections on issues of African development to do so for a few months at the university. The fellowship, which is part of the African Studies programme of JHU, done annually on a competitive basis will however privilege ECA staff in the selection of fellows.
