


“ IDEP Training Impact Data ”


In 2018, IDEP commissioned a survey to identify a suitable distance learning approach which would enable economies of scale and have impact to a larger audience. For this purpose, an online questionnaire was submitted to 300 former trainees of the institute and it contained 24 questions. 259 responses were received and this was a very positive result being 86% of the targeted group. This summary shows an overview of those results.

Survey respondents had participated in different types of IDEP courses





“ Fellowship programs and research meetings are an important framework for sharing and interacting between researchers and decision-makers. ”


New skills were applied and acknowledged by colleagues and supervisors
