

Key Elements of the Statutes

African Institute for Economic Development and Planning (IDEP)

- Created in **1962 by the UN-GA**
- Began its operations on **21st November, 1963**
- All 54 African governments are members
- Has its own Governing Council and Budget.
- Subject to the Financial Regulations and Rules of the United Nations and the Staff Regulations and Rules of the United Nations.
- Has a technical advisory committee, a director and support staff.



Primary Purpose

Accompanying & supporting newly independent African countries in their quest to build their human resource capacities as a necessary prerequisite for sustaining independence and promoting socio-economic development

Subsidiary organ of the ECA, with its own Governing Council

- Sub-programme 8 (CoM 2008)
- Training arm of ECA (CoM 2013)

Activities organized around a portfolio of:

- capacity development
- training courses
- Master' programme
- policy research and dialogue initiatives



Governing Council (GC)

Prime oversight and decision-making organ of the Institute and act to give effect to the broad directions established for the work of the Institute by the COM.



10 members appointed by the COM based on equal representation of the five subregions of the African continent.



Members serve on a voluntary basis for a period of three years and eligible for reappointment for one additional term only.

Key Rules and Procedures

Chair:
ECA's ES

Decision:
Two-thirds of the members are present and voting.

Participation:
Limited to designated members

Voting:
One (1) vote for each member

Quorum:
50% plus one (1) member
